MindView 7 AT



Availability: Any networked computer

MindView is a visual learning tool designed to help develop and organise ideas. MindView allows you to visually mind map, organise and present ideas. MindView integrates seamlessly with MS Office applications and Notetalker and offers project management features and advanced collaboration options.

Use MindView to:

- Visualise ideas and concepts
- Make visual notes
- Create action plans
- Create Work Breakdown Structures, Gantt charts and timelines
- Export your mind map to Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Outlook and Project

textHELP Read & Write Gold 11.5



Availability: Any networked computer

TextHelp Read & Write Gold is a reading and writing tool designed to support students with dyslexia. Features include speech feedback, phonetic spell checking, word prediction, a speaking dictionary and a scanning facility.

For example you can listen to text being read aloud in MS Office applications, emails, web pages and PDF documents making it a very useful tool for proof reading work.

Dragon Naturally Speaking



Availability: Open Access room within the library (1 copy only)

Dragon Naturally Speaking voice recognition software allows users create documents and control their PC by voice. Dragon can be used by anyone who would rather say their ideas as opposed to type them. Additionally, Dragon is an effective tool in giving access to computers for those unable to use a keyboard or mouse.

Dolphin SuperNova 17



Availability: Open Access and Support Workers room within the library only

Dolphin SuperNova allows access to a computer through screen magnification, screen reading, changing of colour contrasts and provides Braille display support for people with a visual impairment.

JAWS for Windows



Availability: 1 copy only

JAWS reads aloud content on your computer screen and gives users a set of tools for navigating and accessing web pages and other screen content. JAWS is compatible with Microsoft Office Suite, MSN Messenger, Internet Explorer, Firefox and many more frequently used applications.
