What is Discover@Bolton?

Discover@Bolton is the Library's academic search engine. It allows you to search multiple databases and other resources in a single search. It's packed full of academic content to support your studies.

Why should I use it?

- Easy access to online library resources
- Multidisciplinary - saves you searching multiple platforms
- Content includes ebook packages and subject databases
- Web based with fast results and simple to use

How do I access Discover@Bolton?

Discover@Bolton is available via the Library website. You can access it on and off-campus.

Do I have to sign up to use it?

No, just use your usual university username and password to log in.

Where do I start searching?

It's as simple as Google to use. Just enter your keywords in the search box.
